Proposed changes to the Ideal Green Market Cooperative (IGMC) Bylaws

The following sections are excerpted directly from the current IGMC Bylaws.

Note: The current IGMC bylaws are shown in *blue*, added sentences are shown in *red* and highlighted words are removed, explanation of changes is in black, within parenthesis. No other revisions to any other section of the IGMC bylaws will be made.

Section 3. Quorum

At any meeting of the membership quorum will be 10% of the voting members or 50 members when the membership exceeds a total of 500 for action of the membership to take place. Members physically present at a meeting or by proxy are considered as present for quorum purposes. (The above sentence, in red, is added for quorum clarification purposes only, at a lawyer's suggestion)

Section 4. Voting

Unless otherwise stated in the Articles of Incorporation, or in these by-laws, all questions shall be decided by a vote of a majority of the members voting.

Each member is entitled to one vote. Voting by proxy is **not** permitted.

(The removal of the word **not** from above sentence, allowing for: Voting by proxy to be permitted)

If a membership is held by a partnership, corporation, or other legal entity the member shall designate in writing the person who shall vote on behalf of the member. That designation shall remain in effect until written or electronic notice of a properly authorized change in the designated voter shall be received by the cooperative.

Final appearance of IGMC Bylaw sections 3 - 4

Section 3. Quorum

At any meeting of the membership quorum will be 10% of the voting members or 50 members when the membership exceeds a total of 500 for action of the membership to take place. Members physically present at a meeting or by proxy are considered as present for quorum purposes.

Section 4. Voting

Unless otherwise stated in the Articles of Incorporation, or in these by-laws, all questions shall be decided by a vote of a majority of the members voting.

If a membership is held by a partnership, corporation, or other legal entity the member shall designate in writing the person who shall vote on behalf of the member. That designation shall remain in effect until written or electronic notice of a properly authorized change in the designated voter shall be received by the cooperative.
